




M50 - OVERNIGHT CLOSURE FRIDAY - SATURDAY, 28 - 29 MARCH 2008

New Luas Bridge over M50 at Junction 14 (Leopardstown Bridge)

Construction of the Luas Bridge over the M50 at junction 14 Leopardstown is progressing well. The pier construction is complete and structural steel erection has commenced. M50 closures will be required to lift the structural steel spans that cross the motorway. These closures are planned for the 28th and 29th March from 8 pm both evenings until 6 pm the following morning, weather permitting. Please see map below for diversion routes.






Cherrywood Viaduct


Alternatively to what was mentioned in construction update No 9 of February 2008, we managed to reduce the weekend traffic restrictions to 2 weekends in stead of 6, weather permitting.

During the weekend 15th - 17th March 2008, from 6 am on Saturday 15 March until 6 pm on Monday 17 March there will be lane restrictions in place on Wyattville Linkroad to assist with the installation of bridge beams on the new Viaduct. The same restrictions will be in place during the weekend 22nd - 24th March 2008.

While these works are ongoing, alternate Layout 1 or Layout 2 will be in existence (see above maps). Two way traffic will be maintained at all times. Please follow the diversion signs.

New Luas Bridge over Brewery Road / Leopardstown Road Roundabout

Works have commenced on the erection of the structural steelwork over the Brewery Road / Leopardstown Road Roundabout. The remaining lifts will take place in the coming weeks, weather permitting. As per works to date, the remaining steelwork spans over the roundabout will require localised night time road closures and diversions. These restrictions have worked well so far and will be installed at 8 pm in the evening and the roads reopened by 6.30 am the following morning Monday to Friday. Closures will be extended to 09.30 am on Saturdays and Sundays. For diversion routes please refer to the table and maps below.




Traffic cone layout

Construction Update 14 March 2008

Glenamuck Bridge and Road Upgrade Works

Works are progressing well at Glenamuck. The majority of the bridge superstructure is now complete. Works on the remaining wing walls and the new road boundary walls are in progress. Please note that for safety reasons, all cyclists must dismount from their bicycle while utilising the dedicated footpath and mopeds or motorised transport are not permitted at anytime on this footpath.

New Luas Bridge over M50 at Junction 15 (Carrickmines Bridge)

Construction of the Luas Bridge over the M50 at Carrickmines continues to progress at pace. Construction of the bridge deck is nearing completion and works on the parapets have commenced.

UTILITY DIVERSIONS

Ballyogan Road

Surfacing has been laid along part of the new Ballyogan Road alignment. Road Traffic will be switched onto this new section of road when footpaths and public lighting works are completed. A speed limit of 30 kph will be implemented until the final surface is in place.

Temporary traffic lights have been installed at the Carrickmines end of the Ballyogan Road to facilitate the construction of the new road. These temporary traffic lights will be moved westwards along Ballyogan Road as each section of new road is completed.

Sandyford Park and Ride

The diversion of the water main on the Sandyford car park is ongoing. The completion of the diversion of utilities will be followed by the track work.

TRACK AND CIVIL WORKS

The main infrastructure contractor, Somague Bowen Sacyr JV, will be mobilising to site shortly to commence construction of the track and power systems. Ground clearance and track laying activities are set to commence in April inside the existing Sandyford Depot. This will provide additional tram storage facilities. The upgrading of Sandyford Luas Stop to provide a third platform and additional connecting tracks will commence shortly thereafter.

GREEN LINE PARK AND RIDE FACILITIES

Stillorgan Carpark

Pockets of work are ongoing on the Stillorgan Park and Ride to assist the local council in the improvement and widening scheme for the Drummartin Link Road and Blackthorn Avenue. Over the coming weeks. A new entrance will be created into the Stillorgan Park and Ride and a new traffic island will be constructed to lead pedestrians into the new entrance in a safe manner.

Sandyford Car park

Please note that pay & display and day rate parking is provided by the local authority in the Sandyford Industrial Estate and Stillorgan Industrial Park.
