Proposed Short-Term Traffic Management Measures at M50 Leopardstown Roundabout

Description of Project

For traffic safety reasons at the M50 Leopardstown Roundabout, it is proposed to install short-term traffic management measures at the roundabout, in advance of permanent modification works, which are programmed to occur in the early summer.

These short-term traffic management measures include provision of temporary safety barriers, new road markings and temporary road signs.

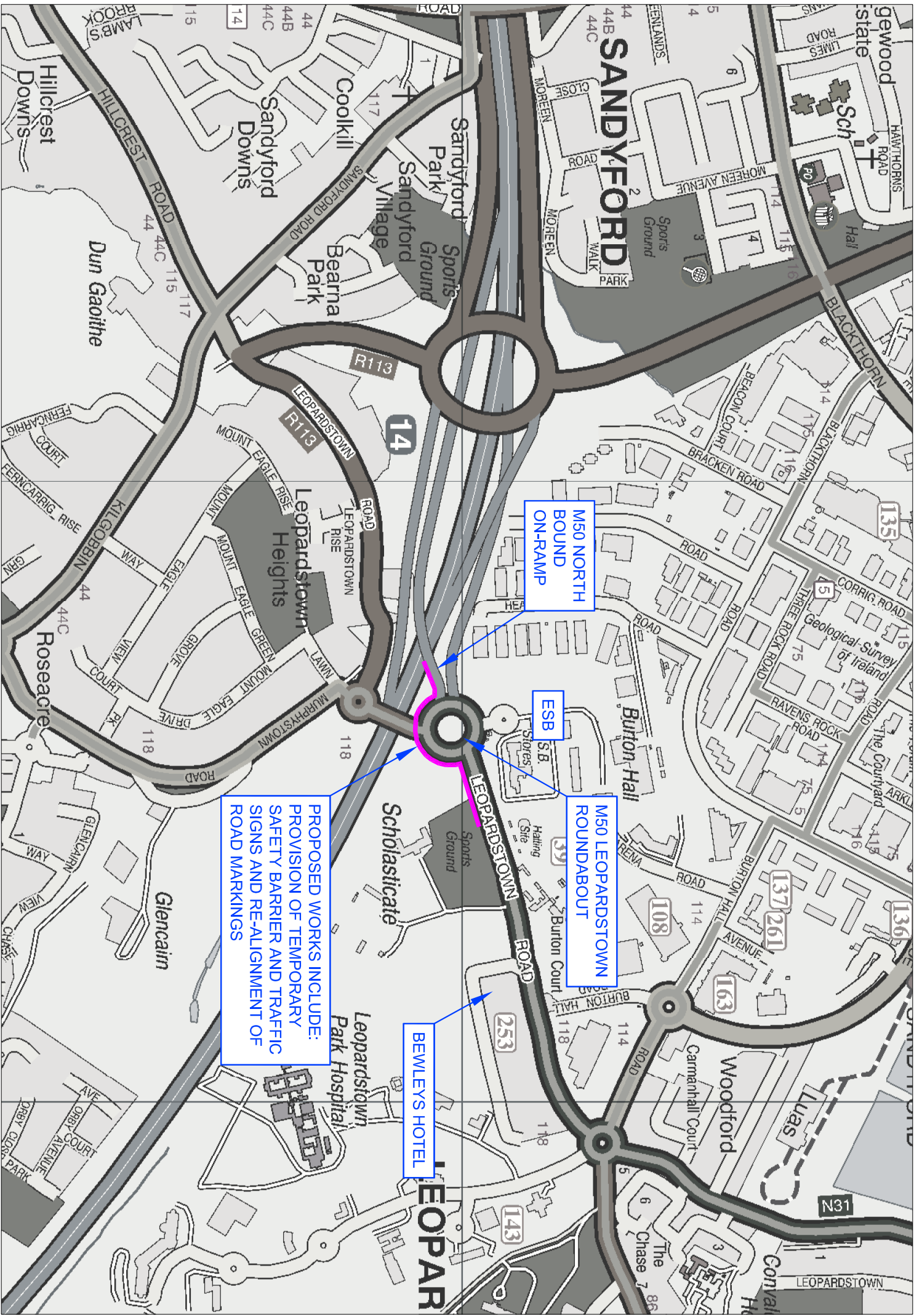
Traffic Management Information

The works are programmed to be carried out during night-time hours, 10pm to 6am. The works are not anticipated to cause any disruption to normal traffic flow.

To facilitate the works, appropriate traffic management will be undertaken, which will include the reduction of traffic to a single lane for the duration of the night-time working. Each morning on completion of works, the road will be reinstated to two lane traffic flow.

Expected Duration

The works are expected to be of approximately two night's duration and will commence subject to weather conditions during the course of the week beginning Wednesday night 16th January 2008 at the earliest.
