ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Leopardstown Roundabout & adjoining areas – Night Work only *

Survey work is due to be carried out of all existing utilities on and around the Leopardstown Roundabout and adjoining areas between 8.00p.m. and 5.00a.m. (night work only) from Tuesday, 19th March 2013 and will be completed with in two weeks. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» M50 Northbound Carriageway from Junction 13 Ballinteer to Junction 11 N81 – Night Work only **

Lane 3 will be closed from 22:00 hours on Tuesday 19^{th} March 2013 till 06.00 hours on Wednesday 20^{th} March 2013 to facilitate road sweeping. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Project Diageo (Guinness) Abnormal Load Movement from
Dun Laoghaire Port via Monkstown Road – Rock Road – Blackrock
Bypass – Merrion Road to Diageo (Guinness) Victoria Quay ***

An abnormal load movement (6 vehicles in convoy) will take place from 22.00 hrs on Tuesday 19th March to 6.00 hrs on Wednesday 20th March 2013. The movements will transit from Dun Laoghaire Port via Dun Leary Rd – Monkstown Crescent – Monkstown Rd – Frascati Rd – Rock Rd – Merrion Rd – Northumberland Rd – Mount St – Contra Flow Nassau St – Westmorland St – Aston Quay – Guinness Victoria Quay. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Killiney Towers Roundabout ***

This roundabout is located at the junction of Killiney Road, Barnhill Road, Avondale Road, Glenageary Road Upper and Albert Road. Works will be carried out to upgrade the existing roundabout from Monday, 11th March to Friday, 26th April 2013. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Taney Road/Dundrum Road (Night Works) ***

Drainage works will take place on Taney Road/Dundrum Road under the LUAS Bridge commencing Monday, 11th March, 2013 to Friday, 22nd March, 2013 from 7.00pm to 6.00am. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Goatstown Road **

Upgrading of lanterns and public lighting ducting works will take place at various locations along Goatstown Road from Monday 11th February to Sunday 31st March 2013 between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Farmhill Road, Goatstown *

Sealing joints and overbanding works will take place at Hollywood Park, Goatstown from Monday 18th February to Friday 22nd March 2013 from 8.00am to 5.00pm. A Give and Take Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 adjacent to the junction with Cherrywood Road **

A new pedestrian crossing is being constructed on the N11. Works will take place on both carriageways from 8.00am to 6.00pm daily. Work affecting traffic on the N11 will be restricted to between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation. Works are expected to be completed by the end of March.

Wyattville Dual Carriageway **

Works will take place from Wednesday 2nd January to Friday 4th April 2013 from the hours of 10.00am to 4.00pm to facilitate public lighting upgrading on the West bound carriageway of the Wyattville Dual Carriageway. A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.
